Lemon juice and vinegar are acids because their pH levels are less than 7. The soapy water and baking soda solutions are bases because their pH levels are greater than 7. In addition to having pH levels below 7, acids react with metals and carbonates, and turn blue litmus paper red.

Strong acids and bases ionize to a large extent to form many hydrogen or hydroxide ions and have a large acid or base dissociation constant (K_a or K_b). Weak acids or bases ionize to a small extent to form few hydrogen or hydroxide ions and have a small K_a or K_b . An example of a weak acid is acetic acid.
